## College of Southern Idaho Associate Degree/Gem Stamp Important Information

- \* 15 total credits must be taken from CSI to get the Associates through CSI.
- \* Academic Certificate (also called "GEM STAMP") requires 36 core credits as indicated. By completing the core requirements students generals are complete in all Idaho Colleges ONLY.
- \* Associate Degree is First Two Years of College = 60 Credits (36 Core and 24 Electives Credits).
- \* The Associate Degree works for both Associate of Art (AA) and Associate of Science (AS). Please Reference CSI Degrees online for any more specific associate degree information. (Each degree may require specific general education courses in each area.)
- \* Please let your high school counselor know if you sign up for a C.S.I. online class on your own directly.
- \* CSI allows students to register online for any of their dual credit courses. Go to [CSI.DUALENSROLL.COM](http://CSI.DUALENSROLL.COM)
- \* Associate Degrees and Academic Certificate Completers can walk in CSI Graduation in May of Senior Year.
- \* It is your student's responsibility to follow the outlined associates schedule. If your student deviates from the path, the counselors and CSI advisors cannot guarantee that your student will be able to complete their associate's degree.
- \* Your student receives funding from the state to cover their associate's degree. If you deviate from this path and take non-associate college courses, you will be forced to pay out of pocket for any college course once your student's funding runs out.
- \* If you complete your entire Associates Degree, the money from the state will not quite cover the entire cost. You receive an approximate \$4,100 from the state but it falls short by about \$500.
- \* If you fail a dual credit course the state will turn off funding until you pay and pass another course. Please consider this when registering.
